HOLY WEEK DEVOTIONS



1 Corinthians 15:1-10

Get your Bible - open up and read the passage. Pray that God would help you to understand the passage and help you to spend time this week reflecting on Jesus!

As we enter into Holy Week, we have an opportunity to focus in on what Christ has done for us... maybe more intentionally than we typically would.

My hope is that we would KNOW and truly understand the GIFT of grace that Christ came and died to offer to us!

2 Corinthians 5:21 - "For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ."

Romans 6:23 - "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord."

Jesus, our Salvation, the forgiveness of sins - it is a free gift! Offered only by the grace of God!

The truth that "Christ died for our sins, just as the Scriptures said." (1 Corinthians 15:3) should make us constantly thankful and constantly hopeful that we can share this truth with others.

Below are some questions for you to reflect on today!

REFLECT:

How has the gift of Christ changed your life?

Do you ever struggle to stay thankful for Jesus?

How can you share the gift of Christ with someone this week?

How can you be intentional about focusing on Christ during this week (Holy Week) as we prepare to celebrate Easter next Sunday?

PRAY:

1. Pray that God would help you this week to be reminded of the goodness and the grace of Jesus.
2. Pray that God would help you to be intentional this week about celebrating Holy Week.
3. Pray that God would help you to share the good news of Jesus with others.
